

## MYOLOGY OF DUGONG: CORRIGENDA

In the course of this study several misinterpretations in my description of *Dugong* (Domning, 1977a) have become evident. These may be briefly listed here. The lateralis nasi seems to be chiefly a depressor of the floor of the narial passage rather than a manipulator of the snout. Most of the supposed "zygomandibularis" should probably be considered a superficial temporalis, and most of the "orbicularis oris" seems to correspond to the sphincter colli profundus pars oris of the present work. The supposed "aryepiglotticus"

was evidently the palatopharyngeus. The "?abductor pollicis longus" seems to correspond to Murie's "extensor secundi internodii pollicis", probably equivalent to the extensor pollicis brevis. The palmaris longus is more likely absent than fused with the flexor carpi ulnaris. The supposed "urethralis" was in fact the anterodorsal part of the constrictor vestibuli, the true urethralis having been overlooked; the supposed short medial slip of the constrictor vestibuli was not a muscle but rather the bulbus vestibuli.
